











Termly Curriculum Overview: Year 1, Autumn Term 2



English	Maths	Science
 <p>Our focus remains on sentence structure, making sense, full stops, capital letters and spelling with Fred fingers. We will be exploring these skills through two stories 'Katie in London' and 'Katie in Scotland.'</p> <p>Practice spelling common exception words. Read some stories that contain rhyming words e.g. Julia Donaldson.</p>	 <p>We will be moving on to learning about the process of subtraction before looking at the relationship between addition and subtraction through number families. We are also going to be learning about coin values and 3D shapes.</p> <p>Play shops to help learn coin values. Look at packaging- which 3D shapes can you find?</p>	 <p>This half term we are learning more about Autumn and exploring how the day length changes during different seasons. We are also going to be learning about parts of a tree and naming different types of tree.</p> <p>Go for an Autumn walk. Look for deciduous and evergreen trees.</p>

 <p>In History we are going to be learning about the Gunpowder plot and the key historic figures linked to the plot.</p>  <p>In Geography we are going to be learning about which country we live in and which countries make up the UK. We will be focusing on one of the four countries each week and the capital cities.</p> <p>Look at some photos/pictures of London landmarks.</p>	 <p>In Art we are going to be focusing on art work by Tom Butler who creates collages of London landmarks using newspaper. We are also going to be learning how to draw portraits.</p>  <p>In Design Technology we are going to be learning how to cut food safely and create a face pizza.</p> <p>Prepare dinner with your child helping.</p>	 <p>We will continue to teach the importance of keeping safe online while exploring the save and print functions on the computer.</p> <p>Ensure you have parental controls on your children's devices.</p>
