



Glendale Infant School Early Bird & After School Club Pack

Early Bird and After School Club is available to all children attending Glendale Infant School.

At the club the children will be able to participate in a wide range of activities, with opportunities to play a variety of games; physical activities, food activities, arts & crafts, as well as having the chance to relax or read. We aim to provide a safe and fun environment.

The application form within this pack must be completed and returned for each child you wish to register at the club. If your child is not registered to attend they will not be given a space in any session.

Early Bird Club

Early Bird Club operates during school term times and welcomes children from 08.00am each morning. It does **NOT** provide breakfast.

Sessions have to be booked in advance on the School Money app. You will be sent login details and user instructions once your child has started school. You **CANNOT** turn up with your child(ren) on the day, they must already be registered to attend and be booked in via School Money. Payment needs to be in advance, a place may well be refused if this is not the case.

The cost of the session is £4.00 from 08.00am per child
(Children can be dropped off anytime between 8am and 8.30am)

After School Club

After School Club, as with Early Bird Club, operates during term time and is available from the end of school at 3.30pm until 5.00pm and places must be booked in advance. The club provides toys, games, crafts and physical activities. A snack and drink is provided for the children as they arrive at the club.

The cost of the session is: £3.00 until 4pm per child. (½ hour)
£7.00 until 5pm per child. (1 ½ hours)

Staffing and other details

All staff are qualified or appropriately experienced and have an enhanced DBS check. The club is run according to the guidelines set out by Ofsted. There will be a qualified first aider on site at all times. As we are registered with Ofsted through our school registration, the club will be inspected alongside the school.

Bookings

Bookings for Early Bird and After School Club need to be made by **4pm Thursday** in the week prior to needing the space(s) via the School Money app. Bookings open each week on a Monday morning and close on a Thursday at 4pm.

Fees

Early Bird Club - £4.00 from 8.00am per session, per child

After School Club - £3.00 per child until 4.00pm/£7.00 per child until 5pm.

Contact Details

The Early Bird and After School Club may be contacted during club hours, by telephoning 07398 270603. A message can be left at other times and the club lead will pick these up on a daily basis. In an emergency you can contact the school office.

General Details

- When dropping off or collecting children, please enter via the Reception gate.
- All children attending the Early Bird Club will be taken to their class in time for registration.
- The teacher or TA will accompany reception children attending After School Club to the "the link".
- If your child attends an after school activity they will be escorted to the club afterwards.
- Children will have access to drinking water at all times.
- The staff will inform you of any accident/incidents affecting your child, all accidents are recorded and an adult's signature will be required on collection.

Terms and conditions of care

By signing the application form, I hereby agree to abide by the following terms and conditions;

- All days **not** attended **must** be paid for in full, if you have contacted school to inform that your child is off school due to illness, a credit will be applied to your account.
- I/we will supply any additional information, which may be significant in caring for my child on enrolment. Including but not limited to allergies, religious dietary requirements and any additional needs.
- I/we will ensure that staff are advised of any specific care plans that may be in place for my child.
- I/we will telephone the club and make them aware of any changes regarding who will be collecting my child(ren.) I/we will ensure they are 15 years or older and they have the pre-arranged password (on the application form.) I/we understand that if this procedure is not followed my child/ren will **NOT** be able to leave the premises.
- I/we understand that should I be late to collect my child a charge will be imposed of £15 for every 15 minutes, or part thereof after 4.00pm/5.00pm.
- I/we understand that places for Early Bird and After School Club must be booked in advance, by **4pm Thursday** in the week before.
- All payments must be made in advance for After School Club and Early Bird Club. Failure to comply on 3 occasions will result in your child(ren's) places being withdrawn.
- I/we will ensure our child(ren) has/have been signed in/out by a member of club staff before leaving the building.
- Persistent late collections may lead to the loss of my child(ren's) place at the club.
- I/we will keep the club updated of any changes in circumstances.
- I/we understand the club accept no responsibility or liability for any valuables brought to the club by any child.
- The club reserves the right to revoke a place on the grounds of anti-social behaviour or any repeated behaviour affecting the well-being of the club in general.
