










Termly Curriculum Overview: Year 2 Autumn Term 1



Where in the world am I?

English	Maths	Topic; Geography
<p>Our key text this half term is 'The boy who sailed the world' by Julia Green. We will be developing our sentence construction and continuing to embed capital letters and full stops. We will work on using adjectives, verbs and nouns to describe over the half term, we will write character descriptions and setting descriptions, narratives and poetry.</p>  <p><i>Ask me what a noun and adjective are!</i></p>	<p>In maths, we will be learning about number and place value and how to partition a number in a variety of ways. We will move onto addition and subtraction, learning how to partition into tens and ones. You can practice adding two numbers together at home. Use objects to help you see how many you need to increase by, we will consolidate using jottings to add and subtract too. We will practice using base 10 equipment to partition, and using the part, part, whole model.</p>  <p><i>Ask me how I can partition a number into tens and ones.</i></p>	<p>In topic, we will be learning about the world we live in! We will learn about the United Kingdom, the four countries and what makes them all different and the seas which surround the United Kingdom. We will look at the weather in the United Kingdom and compare this to countries around the world. Children will learn about the 7 continents and the 5 oceans of the world and the equator.</p>  <p><i>Ask me about the United Kingdom and the 4 countries.</i></p>
<p>In Physical Education we will be learning all about dance. We will learn a range of different dance techniques; musical dance, African dance, line dance and Irish dance! We will learn to move with the rhythm of music and express ourselves in a similar way to the style we are learning! Children will need their PE kits in school so that they can get changed and take part in PE every week.</p>  <p><i>Ask me to show you a dance I have learnt!</i></p>	<p>In art we are learning about Edward Tingatinga, who created the style 'Tinga art'. We will learn about the history of Tinga art, where it originated from, why it is popular and how it is created. We will then learn lots of different techniques such as sketching, colour shades, watercolours and eye shapes to be able to then create our own pieces of Tinga artwork!</p>  <p><i>Ask me where Tinga art originated from!</i></p>	<p>In Religious Education we will be learning all about Judaism this half term. We will learn about what is precious to Jewish people, what they do in their daily lives to demonstrate their faith, how and why they celebrate Shabbat.</p>  <p><i>Ask me about a Mezuzah and what it is.</i></p>
<p>In computing this half term, we will be learning about algorithms, what they are, how they work and exploring using them on computers in our computing suite.</p>  <p><i>Ask me what an algorithm is!</i></p>	<p>In Personal, Social, Health Education this half term we will be reminding the children of the school rules and expectations when at Glendale. We will review our protective behaviours scheme where we will discuss our network hand and early warning signs. We will move onto our Captain Values focus for this half term which is independence and being able to show it, and learning how to be independent learners. We will learn about British Values, in particular democracy, what it is and how it impacts us. We will focus on Black History month during October too!</p> <p><i>Ask me what independent means!</i></p>
