In line with our topics this term, we have arranged a visit to:

### **Attwell Farm Park on Tuesday 18th April 2023**

The visit includes a guided tour of the farm, animal handling session, animal feed and indoor and outdoor play areas. The children will need to wear sensible shoes and their school uniform. However, if the weather looks to be, or has been wet, they can wear jeans or joggers and wellies with their school jumpers.

Please send your child in with a packed lunch, sent in a plastic bag, with throwaway wrappings/cartons, in order that all rubbish can be thrown away before returning to school. Children entitled to free school meals will receive a packed lunch from school. Coach/es will leave around 9.15a.m; the children should be back in school by 3.30p.m.

We are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of **£20.00** towards the trip. The deadline for contributions is: **Friday 31<sup>st</sup> March**, if insufficient contributions are received the trip will be cancelled.

**The total cost for the trip including entry and travel is:  
£1994.50 ÷ 89 children across the year group = £22.41 each.**

*Free School Meals, children whose parents receive certain benefit, can use 'Get Into It' funding to pay for this trip. Please inform the school office if you want to access this funding. If any parent has any problems or queries about the cost, please see your child's teacher. The children will not need any spending money on the day.*

Volunteers are needed to help supervise groups of children on the day. Please let your child's class teacher know if you are available to help. Any offers of help would be gratefully received, although if we have too many, names will be drawn from a hat.
