



Stratford Butterfly Farm.

As part of our summer term topic, we are learning about living things.

We have organised a trip to Stratford Butterfly Farm on **Tuesday 14th June 2022** where the children will have a guided tour by their staff.

There will also be some time for the children to enjoy the park with their teachers and friends and enjoy a picnic lunch.

We realise that this is the first and last visit that the children will be able to enjoy at Glendale so we have arranged a trip that we hope will be both educational and enjoyable.

The coaches will leave at 9.10am and the children will be back in school by 3.00pm.

Please send your child with a packed lunch, sent in a named plastic bag with disposable wrappings/cartons, in order that all rubbish can be thrown away before returning to school. Children entitled to benefits based free school meals will receive a packed lunch from school.

£1185.60 ÷ 83 children in year group = £14.28 per child	

We are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of **£14 per child**. This will cover the cost of coach travel to Stratford, entry into the Butterfly farm and a guided tour. Payments are to be made online via your school money account by Monday 6th June. If you need a reminder of your login details for this please contact the school office.

Children whose parents are in receipt of certain benefits (job seekers, income support, etc.) can use "Get into it" funding to pay for the visit if they wish.
