









Termly Curriculum Overview: Year 1, Summer Term 2

Once Upon an Ocean



English	Maths	Computing
 <p>Our literacy focus remains on topic related books including <i>Grandad's Island</i> and the <i>Journey Home</i>. The children will create some descriptive writing about Grandad's island and what can be found there before they complete a story retelling, remembering to use full stops, capital letters and finger spaces. We now have 3 Year 1 children with a blue handwriting pen licence and some others who are very close!</p> <p>Practice spelling common exception words. Talk about the characters, setting and plot of stories read at bedtime.</p>	 <p>This half term we are recapping addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also focus on time (o'clock and half past), positional language, money, shape and rotation ($\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ and whole turns.)</p> <p>Name 2D and 3D shapes in the environment.</p> <p>Help your child to tell the time to o'clock and half past.</p>	 <p>We are continuing to learn about algorithms. This half term the children will be following instructions to build Lego models. They will then use programming blocks to make them move when specific keys are pressed.</p>

 <p>This half term we will be focusing on some athletic/race type activities in preparation for sports day. After sports day we will be continuing with our games unit.</p>	 <p>We continue exploring animal classification. We are going to be sorting animals by what they eat. We are also going to be looking at the structure of a flowering plant and naming some common wild and garden plants.</p> <p>Name some common plants found in the garden such as daisy, buttercup etc.</p>	 <p>We are going to be focusing on the artist MessyMsxi. She produces environmental art which focuses on pollution. The children will practice drawing sea creatures before they use a paint wash to represent the water. After which they will add their own pollution to their finished picture.</p>

<p>We are going to be learning about the seaside town of Llandudno. We will be looking at physical and human features as well as what you can do there that is different to things we can do in Nuneaton.</p> <p>Talk about physical and human features that you see in different places that you visit.</p>	<p>In DT we are going to be designing and making our own flags. The children will learn how to do a simple running stitch as well as exploring how to attach materials together using glue and staples.
